

<u>Soler - To Usually</u>	
Suelo + infinitive	I usually
Solía + infinitive	I used to
<u>Gustar - To Like</u> <i>See Full 'Using Gustar' Notes</i>	
Me gusta + infinitive	I like (to)
Me gustó + infinitive	I liked (to)
Me gustaba + infinitive	I used to like (to)
Me gusta más + infinitive	I really like (to)
Me gustó más + infinitive	I really liked (to)
Me gustaba más + infinitive	I used to really like (to)
Note - gustar más can be translated as <i>to prefer to</i> , and más can be substituted for mucho, to mean <i>I really like (to)</i>	
<u>Encantar - To Love</u>	
Me encanta + infinitive	I love (to)
Me encantó + infinitive	I loved (to)
Me encantaba + infinitive	I used to love (to)
<u>Interesar - To Be Interested In</u>	
Me interesa + infinitive	I'm interested in
Me interesó + infinitive	I was interested in
Me interesaba + infinitive	I used to be interested in
<u>Empezar - To Begin To</u>	
Empiezo a + infinitive	I begin (to)
Empecé a + infinitive	I began (to)
<u>Ir - To Go</u>	
Voy a + infinitive	I'm going to
Va a + infinitive	He / She is going to
