<p><b>Me gustaría</b> + infinitive = I would like to</p> <p>Me gustaría follows the same pattern as <i>me gusta</i>, as described in the 'using gustar' notes.</p>	
<p><b>Quiero</b> + infinitive = I want to</p> <p>Querer is a regular verb and can be conjugated as such</p>
